For Spring Placement**

Money raised will be used for Capital Improvement Projects. Engraved bricks will be placed in the "Statue of Liberty Walkway" located directly in front of the Gage County Museum.



\$100 PER BRICK for up to 3 lines, 16 letters per line, including spaces and punctuation.

Your name brick will be placed randomly in the walkway that goes out to the miniature 1951 Statue of Liberty and the 2007 time capsule. The Endicott Clay Products are 4" x 8", terracotta-colored bricks with 16 capital letters per line engraved in HELVETICA MEDIUM font and highlighted with quality black paint.

Your idea and imagination is the next step.

One of the first factories in Beatrice was the Beatrice Building and Paving Brick Works founded in 1889. Commemorate your business by having its name and founding date placed on a brick. Surprise a friend by giving them a brick. Just like you, hundreds of thousands of people called Gage County home. Remember your family with a memorial brick. Put your family name on a brick and the date your family arrived in Gage County.
